Integrating CDEP with a Trust's LMS

THE CHALLENGE

- A Quality Improvement Project identified gaps in diabetes education within the Trust, highlighting the need for more engaging and practical training.
- Staff reported that the existing e-learning lacked interactive elements and practical takeaways, making it harder to retain knowledge.

THE SOLUTION

- To address these challenges, the Trust embedded four CDEP topics into its Learning Management System (LMS) Hey247, using SCORM.
- Hey247 allows the Trust to allocate staffing groups to undertake the training, as well as offers easy user search functionality for seamless, single sign-in access.
- Completion of all CDEP topics is encouraged, but a **flexible approach** was adopted to accommodate the diverse roles of staff across the organisation.
- Undertaking annual diabetes training is mandatory, but staff select which topic will best enhance their clinical practice.
- This flexibility allows staff to have more control and choice, driving better engagement in the process.
- CDEP content serves as the **foundation** for diabetes **face-to-face** sessions the Trust offers, enabling staff to later revisit key concepts and obtain certification via CDEP's online training.
- For **newly qualified nurses**, CDEP is integrated into their **induction training**.
- Following clinical incidents involving diabetesrelated issues, staff are directed to the relevant CDEP training module as a reflective tool, to reinforce safe and effective patient care.

THE BENEFITS

- Boosted Training Uptake: more staff are engaging with diabetes education now that it is seamlessly accessible within the Trust's LMS Hey247.
- Scalable and accessible to all staff:
 open access for all staff, not only targeted
 staffing groups, as integrating CDEP via
 an LMS allows unlimited number of staff
 to access the training.
- Positive Feedback: Improved knowledge retention. Staff find CDEP's bite-sized topics practical and easy to apply.
